**I. God is the author of peace. 1 Corinthians 14:26-33**

*"The Corinthians' public worship practices not only failed to be edifying and convicting, but they also involved \_\_\_\_\_ conduct."*

(Dr. Thomas Constable)

- As a prophet speaks, others are to **judge**. No "word from the Lord" should be received without careful consideration by the \_\_\_\_\_ of the church and also tested by the Word of God.

Worry is sin. When we worry it shows we are not \_\_\_\_\_ God.

**II. Women disrupting the service. 1 Corinthians 14:34-35**

The apparent contradiction is explained by most commentators by saying *"Paul probably means women do not have the right to judge prophecy, something \_\_\_\_\_ to male leadership."*

*"It has nothing to do with prophecy or prayer; it is not \_\_\_\_\_ speaking as such."* (Allan Redpath)

**III. Paul asserts his authority. 1 Corinthians 14:36-38**

*"In these verses, Paul was answering the church member who might say, 'We don't need Paul's help! The Spirit \_\_\_\_\_ to us.'" (Wiersbe)*

- In **1 Corinthians 14:38** Paul was not suggesting that people should remain **ignorant**; otherwise, he would not have written this letter and \_\_\_\_\_ their questions.

**IV. All things done orderly. 1 Corinthians 14:39-40**

Jesus is the only One who is \_\_\_\_\_ of all praise, glory and honor; so if we are exercising Spiritual gifts, they are to be done in His power and for His Glory to edify His body!

- *We exist as a church to bring Praise and Glory to our \_\_\_\_\_, Jesus Christ (through worship, service, unity).*
- *We exist to share the \_\_\_\_\_ with the lost.*
- *We exist to make disciples, \_\_\_\_\_ the Saints (teaching).*
