I. Jesus' family misunderstands. Mark 3:20-21
"He simply was not living a life, so His friends came to
Capernaum to 'lay hold of Him', or to 'take charge of Him'" (Wiersbe)
 Jesus appeared to be crazy because He was doing and saying
things that put Him in direct to the most
powerful people in Israel.
"Only two are at work in the world, the gathering and the
scattering. Whoever does the one contradicts the other." (Morgan)
II. A divided house. Mark 3:22-27
Because these religious leaders could not deny the miracles of Jesus, the
His power to the working of Satan.
"This was an involuntary compliment to the
power and greatness of Jesus." (Expositor's Bible Commentary)
Today the powers of darkness seem so powerful; so, it is important to
realize that Satan has already been Colossians 2:15
III. The unpardonable sin. Mark 3:28-30
The Holy Spirit's ministry is to testify of Jesus, so He is warning these
leaders that they were committing the sin. John 15:2
 Jesus Christ is no longer on earth physically; so, no one can
personally see Jesus perform a miracle and that
power to Satan, instead of the Holy Spirit.
The only unpardonable sin today is committed when a person dies in
and refuses to accept Jesus' free gift of Salvation by grace
through faith.
IV. The plea of the family. Mark 3:31-35
Jesus' own family was convinced that He was "crazy", so they came with
the sole purpose of forcibly Him, to take Him back to Nazare
 Jesus is communicating that as He is fulfilling the will of the
Father, His spiritual family and spiritual matters take
over fleshly interests. John 6:28-29
