4. Read **Mark 10:38**. What was the cup that Jesus said He must drink? **Matthew 20:23, 26:39, Luke 22:42, Jeremiah 25:15-17, Revelation 16:19, Psalm 90:7**
5. Read **Mark 10:43**. Discuss the meaning of the Greek word for **servant** which is *Diakonos* (**Strong's G1249**).
6. Since the nature of Christ's Kingdom is all about the King, Kingdom people are not to love the world. Discuss the way the church should operate. **1 John 2:15-17, Matthew 20:27, Colossians 3:12, Ephesians 4:2, Ephesians 4:11-16, James 4:6, 1 Peter 1:17-19, Romans 12:9-13**
7. What did Jesus ransom us from? **Exodus 29:36, Romans 6:6, Hebrews 12:9-15, Psalm 49:7-8, 1 Timothy 2:5-6**
