I. Some trust in wealth. Mark 10:23-26
Money is, it is neither right nor wrong; because it is an
inanimate object, there is nothing evil or wrong with money.
<ul> <li>"In the case of this young man, his wealth robbed him of God's</li> </ul>
blessing, eternal life." (Warren Wiersbe)
The real issue at hand for the Disciples hearing this saying from Jesus is the
same issue everyone should consider, "How is it to enter the
kingdom of God?"
II. God is the possibility maker. Mark 10:27
The Lord can do anything He wants to do; however, He will not do things
that go against His will or do things that His holy character.
Deductive reasoning: Because heaven is a perfect place, and since
we were all dead in our sins without Jesus; there was no way to
heaven, so eternal life was
Jesus' death was to save this rich man, but he walked away
sorrowful after Jesus told him to sell off his possessions.
III. What the Disciples left behind to follow Jesus. Mark 10:28-31
The rich young ruler did not want to give up to follow Jesus,
but the Disciples left many things to follow Jesus.
The enemy and our own flesh will to us and tell us how we
are missing out on something that we deserve to enjoy, but we
had to give those things up, in order to follow Jesus.
"It is good to have the things money can buy, provided you do not the things that money cannot buy." (Warren Wiersbe)

IV. Practical Application.
Along with Original sin, there are the sins we commit; we can sin by doing
things to God's commands or we can sin by failing to do the
things we know we should be doing.
• If the Bible is in fact true and the <b>Book of Romans</b> is right that the
paycheck for any sin we commit is eternal death; then it would be
good for us to know how to fix that problem.
Call on the name of the Lord, admit that you have sinned against God and
that you need Him to forgive you in order to have a
with Him and to escape eternal death.
